The Narrative Lectionary aims to take a sweep through the Bible starting in September each year and finishing the following Pentecost. Over the summer months we then take a deeper look at different parts or themes in the Bible.

Monday	6th August	Psalm 41
Tuesday	7th August	Psalm 42
Wednesday	8th August	Psalm 43
Thursday	9th August	Psalm 44
Friday	10th August	Psalm 45
Saturday	11th August	Psalm 46

After reading the passage take a few moments to think about/contemplate what you have read, and to finish your time use the following short prayer or The Lord's Prayer. You may also wish to use the daily prayer suggested in our Prayer Diary (available from the Church website, the Kirk Centre or Sanctuary).
