Donations of toiletries would be very gratefully received by **Cyrenians** at this time.



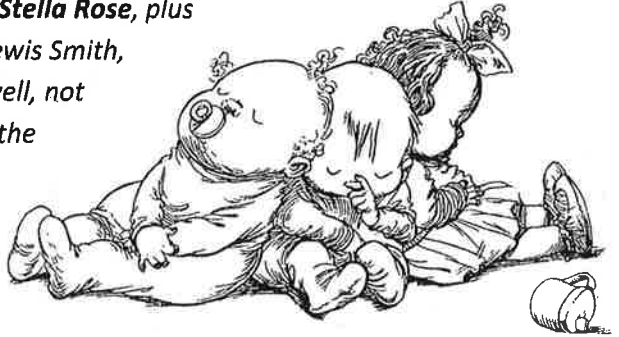
*Were the whole realm of nature mine,
