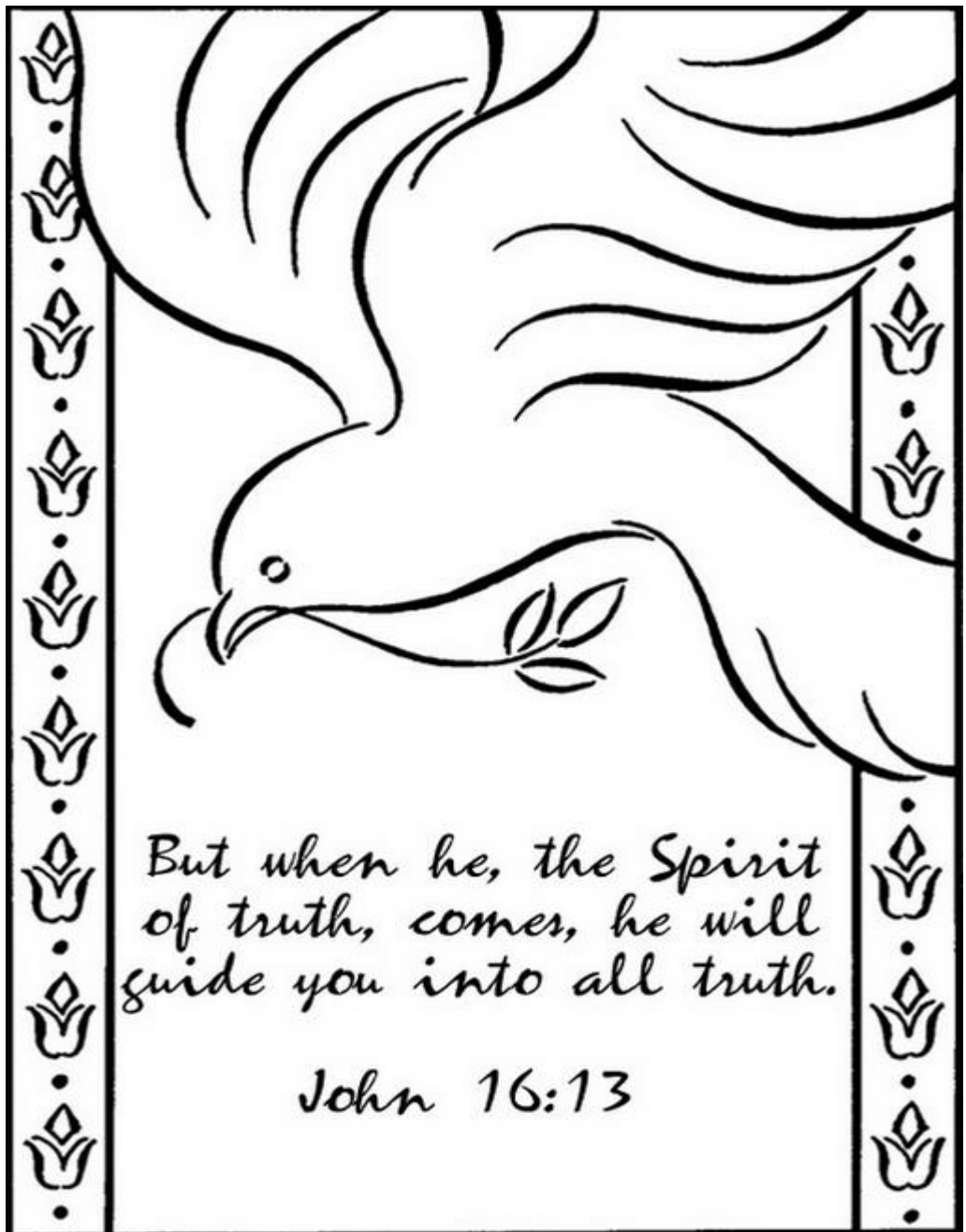


ORDER OF SERVICE
