The Narrative Lectionary aims to take a sweep through the Bible starting in September each year and finishing the following Pentecost. Over the summer months we then take a deeper look at different parts or themes in the Bible.

Monday 18th June	Psalm 10:12-18
Tuesday 19th June	Psalm 11
Wednesday 20th June	Psalm 12
Thursday 21st June	Psalm 13
Friday 22nd June	Psalm 14
Saturday 23rd June	Psalm 15

After reading the passage take a few moments to think about/contemplate what you have read, and to finish your time use the following short prayer or The Lord's Prayer. You may also wish to use the daily prayer suggested in our Prayer Diary (available from the Church website, the Kirk Centre or Sanctuary).
